



We also offer general ultrasound services, as well as DEXA (Bone Density) scanning.

3D Digital Mammography

Our 3D Mammography system from Hologic is revolutionizing how breast cancer is detected. It was the first superior 3D mammography approved by the FDA and is considered the “Gold Standard” for all

women. 3D mammography can be done in conjunction with a traditional 2D C-View generated mammogram, and allows the radiologist to examine your breast tissue layer by layer. The increased visibility provided with 3D images make it possible for a radiologist to gain a better understanding of your breast tissue than ever before, resulting in 40% less callbacks due to a false positive result.

Services

Breast Ultrasound

A breast ultrasound uses sound waves to produce images of your breast tissue and is often used as a follow-up test after an abnormal finding on a screening mammogram. Breast ultrasounds can also be used as an additional screening test in women with dense breast tissue.

Breast Biopsy

A breast biopsy is performed to remove suspicious breast tissue for further examination. These “needle core biopsies” are performed under image guidance with local anesthetic and the tissue is sent to the pathologist for examination.

Bone Density (DEXA)

A bone density test tells you if you have normal bone density, low bone density (osteopenia) or osteoporosis. It is the only test that can diagnose osteoporosis. The lower your bone density, the greater your risk of breaking a bone.

Ultrasound

Ultrasound imaging uses sound waves to produce pictures of the inside of the body. It is used to help diagnose the causes of pain, swelling and infection in the body’s internal organs and to examine a baby in pregnant women. It’s also used to help guide biopsies. Ultrasound can be used to help with guided biopsies, and it is safe, noninvasive, and does not use ionizing radiation. We perform the following exams:

- Abdominal (liver, gallbladder, kidney, aorta, spleen, pancreas)
- Renal (kidney & bladder)
- Thyroid/Parathyroid
- Pelvic
- Soft Tissue (palpable masses any place on body)
- Lymph Nodes
- Chest
- Fetal Age (OB’s)
- Carotid
- Renal Artery Duplex
- Scrotal
- Hernia Sono
- Venous Duplex (DVT)
- Aorta Screening
